**Note:** <sup>1</sup> when you count the number of treads on a step you should include the step top or top platform within the tread count.

**Note:** not all manufacturers treat tread counts, tread heights or platform heights the same - when you compare steps compare the overall platform height not the number of treads as some manufacturers keep tread spacing short.
